

Tournament condition and notes

1. The tournament will be conducted in accordance with Tennis Australia Rules and Regulations and Tennis Australia and member associations Events Discipline Policy and member Protection By-Law.
2. I acknowledge that as a participant in a Tennis Australia sanctioned event I agree to comply with the ITF Rules of Play, the Tennis Australia Events Disciplinary Policy (including its reference to spectator behaviour and interference), the Tennis Australia Member Protection By-Law and the Tennis Australia Anti-Doping Policy.
3. Inappropriate spectator behaviour could result in denial of entry at future Tennis Australia or Member Association sanctioned events, and will be dealt with in accordance with these policies. This includes, but is not limited to tennis venues, hotels and transport vehicles.
4. I consent to be involved in any publicity connected with a Tennis Australia Sanctioned Tournament, including media interviews, photographs and TV footage. Please inform the tournament organiser if you do not wish to be involved in publicity.
5. I consent to Tennis Australia and/or organisers of Tennis Australia sanctioned tournaments to use details provide on the entry form to communicate information about this and future tournaments, via post, email or SMS.
6. It is recommended for every athlete to be a member of an affiliated tennis club within their state of residency.
7. As an entrant in this event, Tennis Australia recommends that your coach is a Tennis Australia certified coach. This will ensure that the coach has currently updated his/her coaching credentials, has been police checked and has an updated first aid qualification.
8. I acknowledge that all Tennis Australia policies can be readily viewed at www.tennis.com.au and that it is my responsibility to view these and seek clarification, if required, from Tennis Australia.
9. Entry closing date is set at 21 days prior to the commencement of the tournament. That is 26 February 2010 for the tournament.
10. For Open and junior singles events matches will be best of 3 tiebreaker sets and Open and junior doubles events will be best of 2 tiebreaker sets with a match tiebreak as the third set.
11. Consolation events will be conducted for all singles events.
12. The required withdrawal date is 14 days prior to the tournament commencing.
13. Events will be seeded by Tennis Victoria using the latest Australian Rankings available.
14. All entrants are to be current registered Playing members of Tennis Victoria or another member association and provide their Registered Player Number.
15. The Diadora Pro Circuit ball will be used exclusively during this event.
16. Age requirements - Junior events are open to all boys and girls, provided they are of the required age or under at midnight, 31 March 2010.
17. Open competitors - may enter in open singles and doubles and one junior singles event as long as they meet the age requirements in junior events above.
18. Junior competitors may enter 3 events - two singles and one doubles. Junior players may enter in the open singles and any other junior singles or doubles events as long as they meet the age requirements in junior events above.
19. Tennis Victoria Player Sanction Fee. This fee applies to all competitors in Australian Rankings Points Open events only.
20. Player registration number. Players must be registered playing members of Tennis Victoria and provide their registration number.
21. All players must report personally to the tournament box upon arrival. Any competitor not ready to play when called by tournament officials may forfeit the match.
22. Entries signed and accompanied by the requisite entry fees will be accepted at the address on the entry form up to and including the published closing date. Doubles partners should enter on the one form.
23. No telephone entries, late entries or entries not accompanied by the requisite entry fees will be accepted.
24. Seedings will be finalised using the latest Australian rankings at the time of entries closing.
25. Skins product or trophies will be awarded to all winners and runner ups in junior singles and doubles events. Prize money will be awarded to all winners and runner ups in open singles and doubles events.
26. Recognised tennis attire must be worn.
27. A referee has been appointed by Tennis Victoria. His or her duties include the right to cancel events, change the length of matches and issue a formal advice, followed by an official warning to a player for behaving in a manner detrimental to the good image of Tennis. Should a player continue to offend, on or off the court during the tournament, after such official warning, the referee may disqualify the player during the match or from taking any further part in the tournament.
28. The tournament manager, in consultation with the referee, reserves the right to reject entries, combine events, have events played away from the major venue's courts and to complete matches under lights.
29. The Boroondara Tennis Centre or Team Tennis accepts no liability for injury or loss of property during the tournament.
30. Tournament organizers and sponsors reserve the right to use names and images of players competing in the tournament for any promotional purposes in media releases and on related web sites.
31. Competitors and tournament officials ONLY will be allowed on the courts.
32. No refund of entries will be made if a player withdrawals after seedings have been done or draws have been finalised.
